Fahd Plan

August 7, 1981

The Fahd Plan consists of eight points calling for:

- 1. Israeli withdrawal from all Arab territories taken in the Six Day War, including Arab (East) Jerusalem.
- 2. The dismantling of Israeli settlements in the territories captured in 1967.
- 3. The assurance of the freedom of worship for all religions in the holy sites.
- 4. The emphasis of the rights of the Palestinian nation, including compensation for those who do not wish to return.
- 5. A brief transition period for Gaza and the West Bank under the auspices of the United Nations.
- 6. The establishment of an independent Palestinian state with Jerusalem as its capital.
- 7. The right for all nations in the area to live in peace.
- 8. The UN or some of its members to guarantee the implementation of the above-mentioned principles.
