

Law Amending Counter-Terrorism Order ([Amendment] No. 2) 5746 (1986)

1. In Article 4 of the Counter-Terrorism Order 5708 (1948) –

(1) Paragraph (g) will be followed by:

(h) Or is a citizen or resident of Israel, who knowingly and without legal authority comes in contact, [in Israel] or abroad, with a man serving on the executive, council or similar body of an organization declared by the Government as a terrorist organization in accordance with Article 8, or representing such an organization;

(2) At [the article's] end, [the following text will be added]:

However, no person would be convicted under Paragraph (h) if it were proven to the court that he made the contact, [in Israel] or abroad, in the context of familial relations with the contacted person, or that the contact was made abroad –

- (1) In the context of assisting a relative in distress;
- (2) Representing a media outlet in a press conference, under the condition that international media outlets are also in attendance;
- (3) Participating in international dialogue on an academic-scientific matter, organized by an academic institution, under the condition that no contact would be made on political matters.
